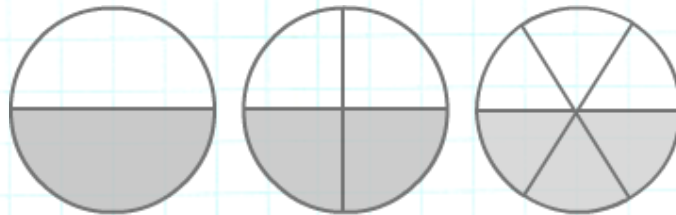




# I'm ready for Grade 5 math because I can...

- read numbers up to 10 000 and put them in order.
- use decimals to tenths and write tenths as fractions
- compare and order fractions, and make equivalent fractions
- add and subtract numbers up to 10 000 and one decimal place
- multiply numbers up to  $10 \times 10$ , and divide to  $100/10$
- multiply and divide whole numbers by 10 and 100
- round numbers to ten, hundred, thousands
- multiply and divide 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers
- name all the coins and bills and count money up to \$100
