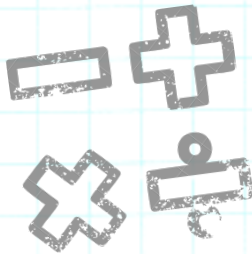




I'm ready for Grade 6 math because I can...

- read numbers up to 100 000 and put them in order.
- use decimals to hundredths and write decimals as fractions
- compare, order, make equivalent fractions and change improper to mixed numbers
- add and subtract numbers with two decimal places, including money
- use multiplication and division facts from memory up to 12×12
- multiply and divide whole numbers by 10, 100, 1000, 10 000
- round numbers to tenths
- multiply 2-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers
- divide 3-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers
